# Instructions to Build Earth Science Notebook

1. A 150 plus page **spiral notebook** is to be used for Earth Science. A new notebook is needed each semester.
2. Only Earth Science notes are in the Earth Science Notebook. Any other class work, (Math, English, and/or History) may cause a loss of points.
3. You must use the Cornell Note format, see the Cornell Notes Instructions.
4. In large, bold print write **Earth Science** on the outside cover.
5. At top outside corner of each page write the page number starting with the number 1 and go to page 100: **do not skip pages**. Add more page numbers when needed.
6. Write **Table of Contents** at the top of page 1 with your full name and period.
7. **Tape** or **glue** the **Instructions to Build Earth Science Notebook** on page 5, **Earth Science Notebook Grading Rubric** on page 6 and the **Notebook's Semester Grading Sheet** on page 7.
8. Attach current quarter's **Homework Schedule** on page 8.
9. Attach the **Cornell Notes Instructions** on page 9.
10. Start your Cornell Notes on pages 10 & 11 of the Earth Science Notebook.
11. Note titles that are **underlined** are to be written in the Table of Contents page with page number.
12. All lecture notes are to be written in the Earth Science Notebook.
13. All notes must be legible and easy to read, and notebook kept in good order.
14. You are to write keywords/questions in the "Keyword Column" area and summarize note material in the "Summary" area.
15. Have your Earth Science Notebook with you in class every day, up to date, and be ready to turn in for grading at any time.
16. All notes are to be hand written, no copy-paste, photos, or photocopies.
17. Write your login and password for your Online Earth Science Textbook on the inside front cover of your Earth Science Notebook.
